This camp is hosted at Camp Mack in Milford, Indiana, and Brethren Heights campers will be camping alongside Camp Mack campers. We will be transporting campers to Camp Mack.

## How to Register

- Visit campbrethrenheightsmi.org and click on the tab labeled Register For Camp.
- 2. Choose between two different versions of the registration form: **PDF and Google.** The PDF form should be sent via postal mail to Camp Brethren Heights, 9478 Brethren Heights Rd., Rodney, MI 49342, while the Google Form will be sent automatically to camp.
- 3. For Otter, Beaver, Bobcat, and Red-Tailed Hawk Camps, complete the Summer Camp Registration Form. For Family Camp and Grand Camp, complete the Family Camp Registration Form.
- 4. Remit a \$50 non-refundable deposit along with the registration form by June 1st for Residential and Eco Camps. (It is only refundable if the camp is canceled.) You can pay the deposit or the full camp fee by mailing a check to the camp or paying via PayPal or Venmo\*\*, whose links and QR codes are included with the PDF and Google Forms. Checks are to be made out to Camp Brethren Heights Inc.

<sup>\*\*</sup> If you pay by PayPal, please increase your payment by 4%, and if you pay by Venmo, please increase your payment by 2%. This is to cover the transaction fee.

# Before Coming to Camp

Two weeks before your camp, we will send you a confirmation packet via email indicating the following: balance due (if any), camper gear list, camper and parent information, check-in procedures, policy guides, health history form, and any adventure camp waiver. Fill out these forms before you arrive at camp. If you don't get your confirmation packet within 2 weeks prior to your camp, you can contact the camp by emailing jemcbride@campbrethrenheightsmi.org or by calling the camp phone at 231-867-3618.



# Discounts & Camperships

#### **Multiple Children Discount**

A discount is available when sending multiple children from the same family to Residental and Eco Camps. For each additional child, you get to take \$50 off that child's camp cost. Please note this on your registration form. (Example: Child 1: \$370, Child 2:\$320, Child 3: \$320, Etc.)

#### **Bring a Friend**

Save money by bringing a friend who has never been to Camp Brethren Heights! By bringing a friend and noting it on your registration form, you will each receive a \$50 discount. This does not apply to siblings.

#### **Camperships**

We believe that no child should miss out on camp because of financial barriers. If your camper is in need of financial assistance to attend Camp Brethren Heights, we have funds set aside for partial or full camperships.

Camperships are granted on a first-come, first-served basis. To get a Campership Request Form, either contact the camp or visit the CBH's webpage and download the form. It is found under the "Camper Forms" tab on the page. A response letter will inform families of granted campership requests.
