Qualifications

- Must be at least 25 years of age
- Previous leadership at Camp Brethren Heights
- Knowledge of group process and its relationship to program implementation

Responsible to CBH Board & Camp Directors

Responsibilities

- Implement objectives of Christian camping
- Recruit camp staff
- Prior to camp, schedule all activities and staff leaders
- Send copy of plans to all staff including the Camp Directors
- Direct all activities during camp
- Meet with staff on a regular basis to evaluate and plan
- Plan for all camp program and "surprises"
- Be available for staff and/or camper consultation
- Keep Camp Directors informed of all problems
- Supervise the weekly staff
- Make sure all staff get breaks if needed
- Report all spending (including donated goods) for the week
- Evaluate camping program and staff at the end of the week, give copy to Camp Director
- Conduct campground checks after lights out

Expectations of all staff

- Attend staff training, even if you have been staff previously
- Reflect the camping philosophy of CBH in all activities
- Attend church on a regular basis
- A desire to know Jesus Christ better and God's plan for one's own life and the need to share that quest with others
- An appreciation for the natural world God has given us, and our stewardship of it
- Keep staff area neat and clean
- Have a commitment to Christ and ability to live as a Christian in daily contact with others
- Be aware that there must always be an adult staff member for every 10 campers
- Be available to counsel campers
- Create opportunities for campers to share in discussion of personal faith and Christian issues in today's world
- Be aware of limitations that some campers may have: emotional, reading, speaking out loud
